Community Toolbox Now Available

The Central Nebraska Housing Developers website now contains information that will help communities and counties develop local housing and economic development plans to enhance their ability to invest in themselves.

Visit the CNHD website at www.cnhdhome.org and click on the "Assistance," "For Communities," or "Need Community Assistance" buttons for the following information:

- Local Option Municipal Development Act This act authorizes incorporated cities and villages to collect and appropriate tax dollars (sales and/or property tax), approved by the local voters, for economic development purposes (including housing). Communities in the Central Nebraska region who currently have approved plans are: Atkinson, Burwell, Ord, St. Paul, and Valentine
- <u>Tax Increment Financing (TIF)</u> Designed to finance public costs associated with a private development project. Essentially, the property tax increases resulting from a development project are targeted to pay the public investment required by a project. A basic TIF outline is included on the site, as well as links to more detailed information. To receive contact information for TIF experts, contact Judy Petersen at 402-340-0106.
- <u>Policy Templates</u> State and Federal funding sources require that counties and communities adopt certain policies and plans, to be eligible for grants and loans. Templates of these policies and plans are provided to assist communities and counties to easily meet these requirements.
